## Oldham County Extension Homemaker Scholarship Application

The Oldham County Extension Homemaker Association may award as many as two \$800.00 scholarships at the County Annual Meeting in May. Upon receiving documentation of payment from the registrar (per semester), \$400 will be awarded to each recipient the beginning of the fall semester and \$400 to each at the beginning of the spring semester. Documentation from the registrar must be received within one month per each semester.

## Qualifications:

- 1. Student applicants must have at least a 3.0 standing from high school or 3.0 if enrolled in post-secondary institution (on a 4 point scale). A copy of an official high school transcript or an official post-secondary education transcript must be submitted with application.
- 2. Applicants over age 21 submit a resume and high school transcript or diploma; or post-secondary education transcript for at least one semester (6 hours) from an accredit college, university or technical school with a 3.0 GPA (on a 4 point scale).
- 3. Applicant must be an Oldham County Extension Homemaker or an Oldham County Extension Homemaker's child or grandchild. The homemaker must be a current member for at least 2 years.
- 4. Applicant must have documentation of acceptance to an accredited college, university, or technical school.
- 5. Applicant can be a full-time or part-time student. (Minimum 6 hours/semester)
- 6. Scholarship recipients may not re-apply.
- 7. Non-recipient applicants may re-apply.
- 8. Scholarship recipients must be enrolled in post-secondary institution accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education.

## **Instructions:**

1. Applications must be postmarked by **April 1** and mailed to:

- 2. The Scholarship Judging Committee will receive all scholarship applications and will make the final decision. At their discretion, they may award two, one, or no scholarships.
- 3. The scholarship recipient will be selected by April 30 and will be recognized at the Oldham County Extension Homemaker Annual Meeting in May.
- 4. All information will remain CONFIDENTIAL.
- 5. If the scholarship recipient is unable to attend college in the fall, at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, the scholarship may be awarded to one of the other applicants.
- 6. Applications will be disqualified if incomplete or with addendums.
- 7. All applicants will be notified by mail of their status.
